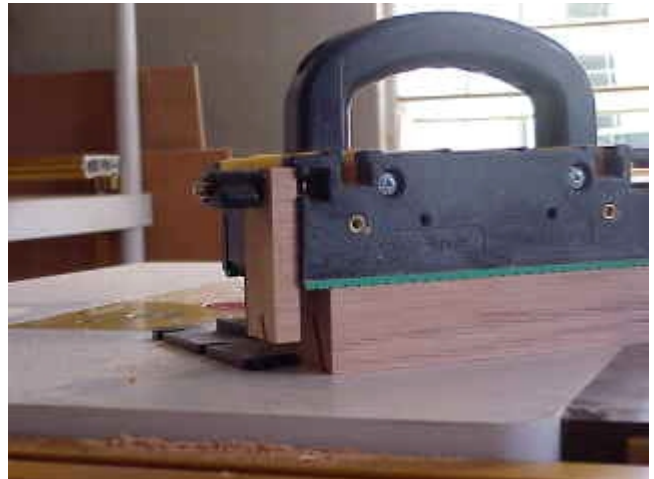


Hello Henry,

I had told you that when we did racks again I'd get some pictures for you, so here they are. The first cut is made on a prepared blank using the Grr-Ripper and a tailpiece to push from behind. The second cut is done the same way. Before the Grr-Ripper this was done with a push block made of wood and was a far slower and more dangerous operation. The other pictures show the tailpiece made of scrap mahogany, and with the rack blank moved away.
